How long does the treatment take?

In order to assess which treatment is right for you, during your consultation your practitioner will take the time to understand what you're looking for and discuss a treatment plan.²⁰ Depending on this, one treatment session can take 20 minutes to an hour.²¹

What does “natural-looking result” mean?

It's all about still looking like you – whether you're smiling, laughing or frowning. During your consultation, your practitioner will assess your face whilst it's still (static) and moving (dynamic) with the aim of giving you a result that looks and feels natural.²⁰

What does the treatment feel like?

Many of the products contain Lidocaine, which is a mild local anaesthetic that helps to numb the area of injection.⁴⁻¹⁰

When can I get back to my day?

With the possibility of minimal downtime, you can get back to doing the things you love on the following day, depending on the treatment chosen.^{1,16}

Any dos & don'ts?

Your practitioner may advise avoiding things like wearing makeup on the treated areas, extended periods in the sun, saunas, ultraviolet (UV) rays or very cold temperatures following your treatment.⁴⁻¹⁰

Your practitioner will work with you to create a unique treatment plan. Your first consultation is dedicated to discovering more about you, the features you love and exploring your treatment needs.²⁰

In expert hands

Like all medical procedures, treatments with facial fillers may cause side effects. To minimise the risks of potential side effects, facial fillers should be only used by medical practitioners who have appropriate training and experience in injection techniques and are knowledgeable about the anatomy at and around the site of injection.⁴⁻¹⁰

What to ask

Here are some things to consider before or discuss during your consultation:

1. How do you want to feel after treatment?
2. What's your practitioner's experience with fillers? And knowledge of facial anatomy?
3. Can they share any before and after pictures? This can help give you a clear idea of what may be possible.
4. Talk about potential side effects, how to minimise risks and after care.
